Straits Project 6:

Replacement of Aids to Navigation Destroyed or Damaged by the Tsunami of 2004

- ❖ China and Indonesia co-operating to replace two of seven identified aids to navigation damaged by the tsunami, i.e. Ule Lhuee and Malahayati Light Beacon in Aceh

Straits Project 1:

- ❖ Multi-beam survey carried out
- ❖ Working with Germany on Wreck Management Information System
