4	Removal of wreck (11 nos)	Reviewed	- Too costly. - Instead of remove, LS agreed to review to monitor the wreck using MyWREMS.





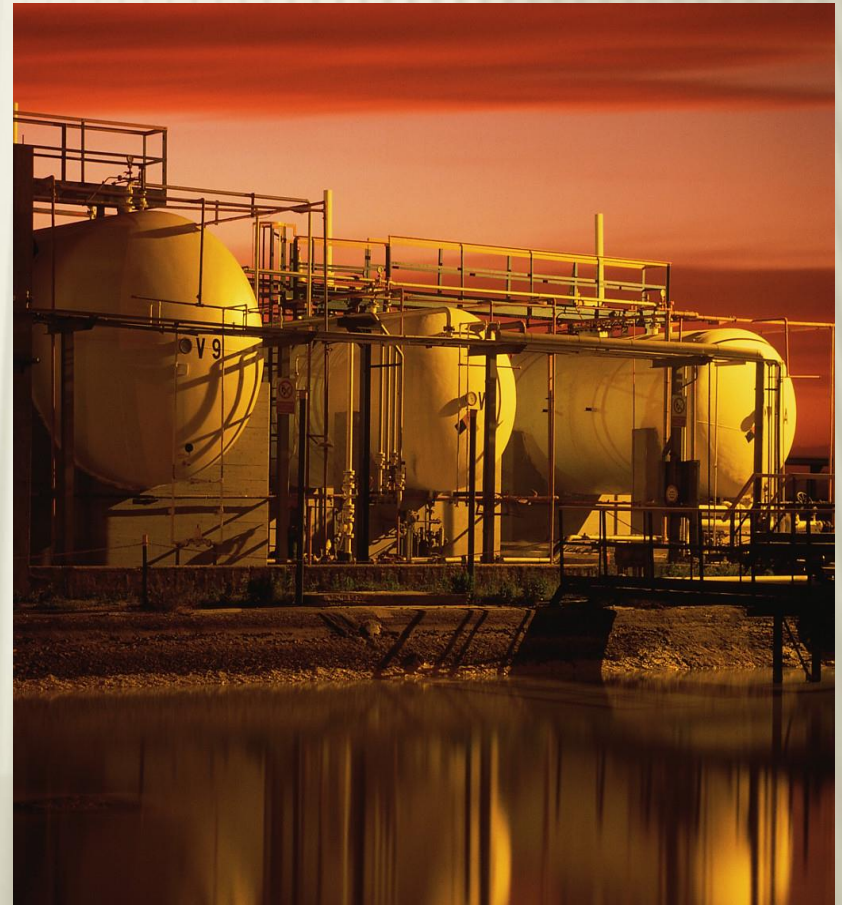
# PROJECT 1: REMOVAL OF WRECKS IN THE TRAFFIC SEPARATION SCHEME AREA

- Received funding from IMO Straits Trust Fund;
- System Training at Rostock, German from 7 – 17 June 2016;
- MyWREMS server will be received by Malaysia on December 2017
- Future Program :-
  - MyWREMS Course to be conducted by 1Q 2018.



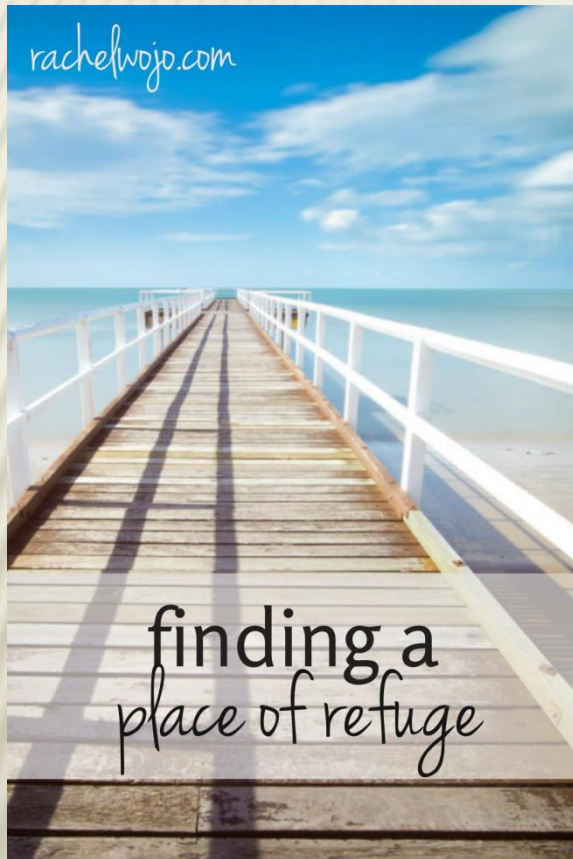
# PROJECT 2 : COOPERATION AND CAPACITY BUILDING ON HNS PREPAREDNESS AND RESPONSE

- Scope:
  1. Risk Assessment & Common HNS databank;
  2. Joint SOP for HNS incident;
  3. HNS Response centers;
  4. Continuous Capacity building;
- China & US conducted needs assessment survey.
- Australia provided technical experts.
- US conducted training on HNS response in October 2008.
- “Train for Trainers” course provided by China in 2010.
- IMO sponsored on the HNS Database – Risk Assessment & training in January 2012 & 2015.
- IMO also funding the Malacca Hazmat Trajectory System to Indonesia and Malaysia. Technology used was from RPS APASA Australia.
- HNS Workshop in 2013 with the cooperation from IOPC Funds & Malaysia;

# PROJECT 11 : DEVELOPMENT OF GUIDELINES ON THE PLACES OF REFUGE FOR SHIPS IN NEED OF ASSISTANCE IN THE SOMS



- Objective - to develop guidelines for the littoral States to designate Place of Refuge in the Straits;
- Funded by IMO Straits Trust Fund of USD 45,000.00;
- Implementation through a workshops in February 2017;
- Engagement with IMO Experts from Maritime Coast Guard Agency (MCGA) United Kingdom
- Future Programme :-
  1. Technical Visit by experts to littoral States in 4Q 2017;
  2. Workshop in 2Q 2018;

# PROJECT 12 : OIL SPILL MONITORING AND RISK ASSESMENT SYSTEM IN THE SOMS



- Coordinator – Malaysia and Co-Lead from Maritime Safety Administration (MSA), People's Republic of China;
- Commencement of two workshops in China in 4Q 2017 :-
  - Oil Spill Risk Assessment;
  - Oil Spill Monitoring System;
- Funding of USD 150,000.00;
