#### In 2014, Singapore hosted

- 12th Meeting of the ANF Committee (16-17 April),
- 13<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the ANF Committee (18-19 September)

#### The meetings discussed

- 2014 and 2015 work plan relating to aids to navigation in the Straits of Malacca and Singapore (SOMS)
- Measures to further enhance effectiveness of the ANF
- Review and revision of 10-Year Plan Maintenance Programme
- Secretariat's study proposal on review of aids to navigation in the SOMS and publicity of the ANF

### **Proposed Budget and Disbursement for 2015**

As of 31 August 2014, the estimated balance amount of ANF available for the maintenance and replacement of aids to navigation is US\$US\$6,047,290.12
