- **Singapore chairs the Aids to Navigation Fund (ANF) Committee (2013 – 2015)**
- **In 2014, Singapore hosted**
 - 12th Meeting of the ANF Committee (16-17 April),
 - 13th Meeting of the ANF Committee (18-19 September)
- **The meetings discussed**
 - 2014 and 2015 work plan relating to aids to navigation in the Straits of Malacca and Singapore (SOMS)
 - Measures to further enhance effectiveness of the ANF
 - Review and revision of 10-Year Plan Maintenance Programme
 - Secretariat's study proposal on review of aids to navigation in the SOMS and publicity of the ANF

Proposed Budget and Disbursement for 2015

As of 31 August 2014, the estimated balance amount of ANF available for the maintenance and replacement of aids to navigation is US\$US\$6,047,290.12
