#### **Environmental Panel led by INTERTANKO**

- Biofouling Management
- Land-Based Pollution

#### **Navigation Panel led by ICS**

- Traffic Separation Schemes
- Small Vessel Traffic
- Navigational Technology

# Places of Refuge

- Resolution A.949(23)
- When tested, lacking in its implementation
- Maritime Maise
- ICS et al push for full implementation
- Liberia et al push for further information and feedback
- Regional desk top exercise to see how it will work

# Impact of anti-piracy measures

- Concern over measures taken by ships
- Lack of compliance with COLREG lights
- Turing off AIS
- Possible increase in risk of collision
- Ascertain the level of compliance
- Additional advice to masters

# Cyber security

- Emerging issue for maritime industry
- Growing area
- FPSO incidents
- Impacts upon operations
- Focus on how to deal with the impacts
- INTERTANKO working on a best practice guide



#### e-NAV

- Lessons learnt from other areas
- MONALISA EU project
- Impacts upon the MEH
- Monitor developments both at IMO and in regions

# **ECDIS** charting information

- Concern over presentation of information
- Software issues
- Member double ECDIS failure

Collect reports of miss-representation of information



# Near misses – reporting and transparency

- Leading indicators for accidents
- Highlight points of concern
- Useful as means to study 'pre-accidents
- Need better collation of near misses
- Need more analysis of near misses
- Requires open and no-blame culture



# 4. Proposed way forward

- Consider emerging and ongoing issues jointly with the LS
- Agree on objectives for environmental and navigational priority items
- Reestablishment of '3+1' meetings to plan project work
  - Coordinated intersessional e-communication also essential
- Report on project proposals to the 8<sup>th</sup> CF 2015
