Project 6: replacement of aids to navigation damaged by the tsunami incident

- The Exchange Letter between the Government of the People's Republic of China and the Government of the Republic of Indonesia concerning the Project-6 Implementation has already signed on the 20 February 2011 at Jakarta.
- The Commencement of work on Project-6 is divided into 2 phases:
 - a. The 1st Phase: "to rehabilitate the first two aids to navigation located in Ulee Lheue Port and Malahayati Port"
 - b. The 2nd Phase: "to rehabilitate the remaining five aids to navigation located in Pulau Bunta, Ujung Pidie, Pulau Beras (Breuh), Tanjung Jambo Aye, and Ujung Tamiang".
- Indonesia has completed the replacement of the 2nd Phase of the Project on 2012.
- In order to commence the 2nd Phase, the soil and water investigation works was conducted by the company appointed by the Government of the People's Republic of China on April-May 2013.



Project 6: replacement of aids to navigation damaged by the tsunami incident

- Indonesia wishes to finance the 1st phase of Project-6 by its own budget.
- The 2nd Maritime Cooperation Committee (MCC) Meeting between the Government of the Republic of Indonesia and the Government of the People's Republic of China, Jakarta, 12 May 2014, agreed the withdrawal of the Project-6 as requested by Indonesia..
- Indonesia proposed that the issues covered by Project-6 are considered completed. Indonesia further proposed that Project-6 is to be discontinued.
- Indonesia proposed that further discussion and communication for the remaining works on Project-6 will be conducted bilaterally between Indonesia and China
- Indonesia would like to thank the Government of the People's Republic of China for the technical assistance and support during the works.
