



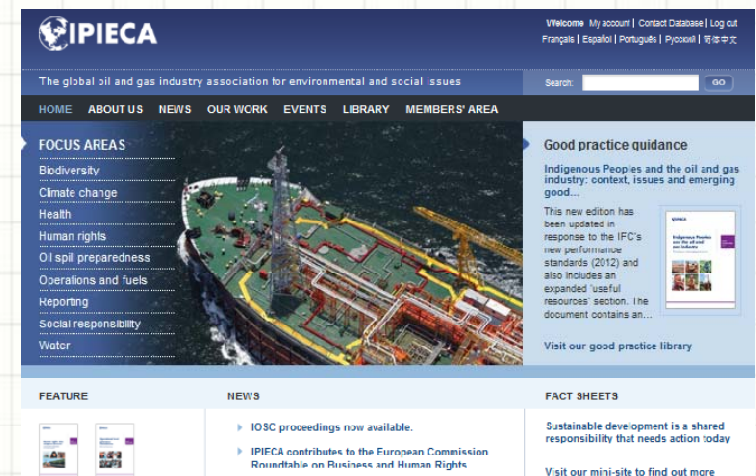

- ◆ Global oil and gas association for environmental and social issues
- ◆ Formed in 1974 following the launch of UNEP
- ◆ The only global association involving both the upstream and downstream oil and gas industry
- ◆ Membership covers over half of the world's oil production



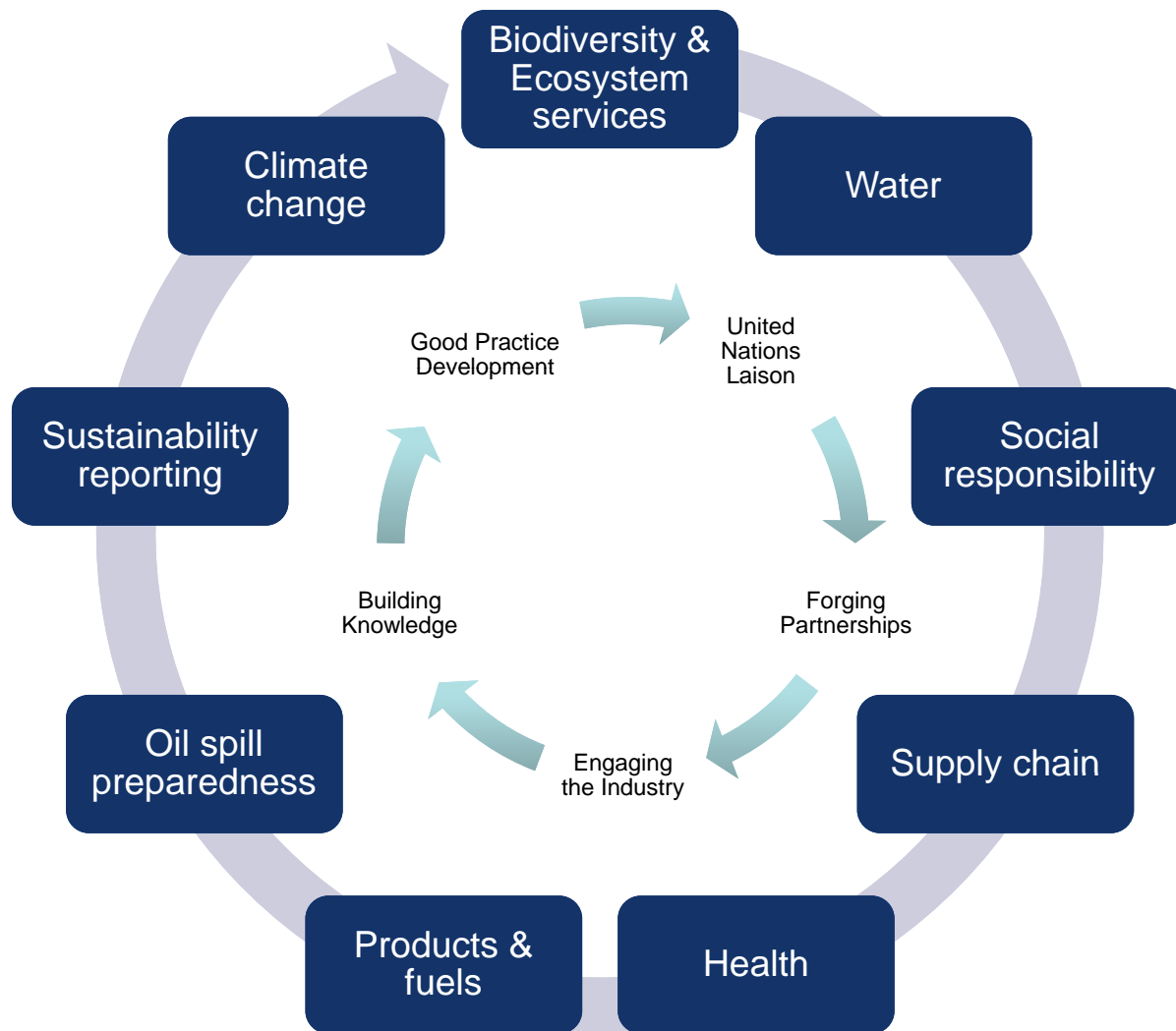
IPIECA members

- ◆ Promote ratification of relevant key international conventions (i.e. OPRC)
- ◆ Assist in the development of national oil spill contingency plans on regional, national and local levels
- ◆ Strengthen existing regional and subregional agreements (i.e. ASEAN OSRAP)
- ◆ Encourage adoption of international standards and industry best practices

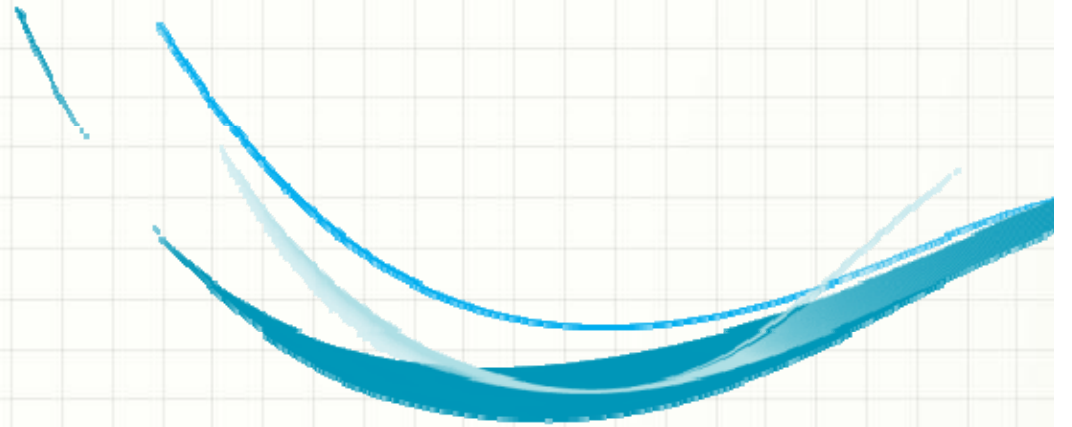




