

# Milestone – Outcome

- Amendment of the working timeline for Project 11, to include an appointment of a Consultant to analyse data submitted in the Fact-Finding Questionnaire and subsequently hold a Third Regional Workshop to deliberate on developing a harmonised guideline for PORSOMS; and
- Consideration of the recent development on the IMO Resolution A.949(23) A Revision of the Guidelines on Places of Refuge for Ships in Need of Assistance
- Further discussion is needed in due course to a greater extent of data and analytical sharing sessions which will be hosted by Malaysia, scheduled to take place on November of 2023.
